## INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE GREEN ECONOMY IN THE APENNINE REGION

The University of Camerino and The European Academy of Bolzano/Bozen – Eurac Research, in collaboration with the Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea - Italian Delegation in Alpine Convention, invite Universities, public institutions and private companies in a conversation on the topic of green economy in the Apennine region.

In the context of the Conference it is opened a:

### CALL FOR GOOD PRACTICES

The call for good practices looks for initiatives and case studies coming from territorial stakeholders at national, regional and local level, such as: Universities, research centers, public institutions, companies, parks, associations.

The national and international good practices must refer to **public, private or mixed initiatives that have a clear link to the sustainable economic development of mountain areas.**

A Scientific Committee will select the practices that especially highlight significant and innovative contributions in environmental, economic and social terms with respect to the following key-topics for a green economy framework:

- energy-efficient and low carbon economy
- resource-efficient economy (e.g. water, forests, land)
- ecosystem services and natural capital-based economy
- an economy supporting quality of life and well-being.

All good practices submitted on the occasion of the call will enter the Conference database and could be included in the Conference proceedings.

*For attending to the Conference no fee payment is required.*

*The Conference language is Italian.*

The selection committee will communicate the results of its selection only to the chosen participants, not later than **May 7, 2018**.

Afterwards, the selected participants will be invited to submit a poster for the presentation of the good practice during the Conference. The poster session is scheduled on May 23, at 9.00 a.m..

The posters must be sent in .pdf format to the Conference email address not later than the **May 16, 2018**, and delivered *in loco* in **the first day of the event**.

The size of the printed poster has to be **70cm x 100 cm (portrait)**.
